### UNDERGRADUATE NURSING PROGRAMS AT WSU VANCOUVER

- Registered Nurse (RN) to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Program - For RNs interested in advancing their careers by earning a Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Classes can be taken on a full-time or part-time basis.

NOTE: WSU offers a range of nursing options statewide:

- The BSN Program, for students new to nursing and interested in becoming Registered Nurses is available on the Spokane, Tri-Cities and Yakima campuses.
- The RN to BSN Program is available in Spokane, Tri-Cities, Vancouver, Walla Walla and Yakima.
- There is an online RN to BSN Program.
- The Master of Nursing Program is available in Spokane, Tri-Cities, Vancouver, Walla Walla and Yakima.

### RN TO BSN PROGRAM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Washington State RN licensure eligibility.
- Junior standing (60 semester hours/90 quarter hours)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher in college courses.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher in the nursing prerequisite courses and a minimum grade of 2.0 in each course:
